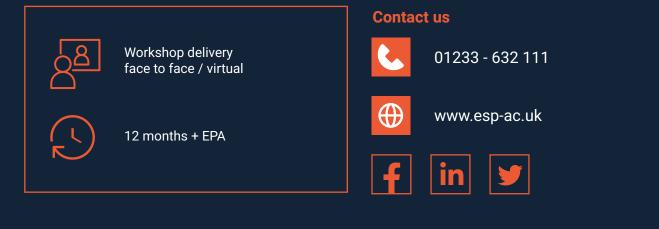
Description

A Network Cable Installer role is responsible for the installation, termination, testing and certification of network cable infrastructure components in accordance with national and international industry standards.

This network infrastructure will provide the communications backbone for the digital infrastructure ecosystem, enabling all types of digital devices including computers, servers, smart devices, security equipment, wireless access points, access control, building management systems and lighting systems to communicate between each other, internally, nationally and globally.
